### Programming idea: Daisy VIP

Before the meeting, cut large daisy shapes from paper – a circle in the middle with all active members names written in each one and at least five petals radiating out from the middle. At the meeting, hand out the daisies to all present. The daisies are passed around the room, and each sister writes a positive word on a daisy petal which describes that sister whose name appears in the middle circle. When the daisies have gone around the room and arrive back at the sister whose name is on it, allow time for each sister to quietly read what her sisters said about her. Fold and send the daisies to those not present with a note. Some may laugh, some may cry, but each will know she is loved.
