

Convention of International Chapter Membership Workshop Involve Your Outer Circles

All of us have an outer circle of friends, coworkers, and acquaintances we've developed in our lifetime. Maybe you come into contact with them frequently through work or social activities; or perhaps you just see them occasionally. Are you talking to them about P.E.O.? Do they know how much P.E.O. means to you? Tell them what we do and how many women we help every year. Tell them about the loving concern we have for each other in this Sisterhood. Talking about P.E.O. to those in your outer circles could be a way of getting them interested in membership.

Be ready with information when they ask questions. You can download the <u>Guide for Nonmembers</u> brochure and be ready with your elevator speech and mission statement whenever the conversation turns to questions about P.E.O. Invite them to your social meetings and fundraisers so they can see for themselves how much fun you have.

Especially be ready to talk about our projects and what we have to offer women to help them reach their educational goals. Be proud to talk about how we have changed the lives of thousands of women through education. And when they show interest in membership, be sure to follow through.

Here is an interesting fact: 43% of the nonmembers who have inquired about P.E.O. membership via Contact Us on the P.E.O. website say they heard about our Sisterhood from a family member, friend or acquaintance. That's revealing – the stories you share about P.E.O. and the wonderful work we do inspires other women. Be intentional about recognizing interest. Follow up by introducing these women to sisters in your chapter or sending an <u>Introduce</u> <u>a Woman</u> form on their behalf. You are their link to membership.

Now is a perfect time to start collecting names on <u>Franc's List Worksheet</u> or add to the lists you've already started. Summer social activities are a good way to introduce those on your list to your chapter sisters. Be ready in October!
