MEMBERSHIP MOMENT- Give the Gift of Time

Consider planning a chapter program where sisters will give each other the gift of time. Here are the directions:

- Sisters should let the planner know of their willingness to participate. Planners, don't be afraid to reach out and get them on board...the more the merrier!
- All sisters willing to participate will have their names drawn to pair them up.
- Give sisters a specified time period (perhaps one month) to spend time together in an agreed-upon activity. Be creative with the activities and have fun. Eat, drink, take a class, watch a game the ideas are limitless.
- For your chapter program, have each sister share what they did and reveal one thing that she learned about her sister. You will likely hear some fun stories, laugh a lot and discover new things about your sisters.
