Loving Concern and a Special Message for Our Newest Sisters Welcome to the P.E.O. Sisterhood!

You may have been in a holding pattern since mid-March because we could not conduct meetings and initiate you into our Sisterhood. Now that we can meet again and can initiate new sisters, your postinitiation counseling is as important as ever. The chapter president will also ensure that a threeyear mentoring program is put into effect for you.

But what can you, as a new initiate, do to fully become a P.E.O.? The following is a checklist of activities adapted from Oklahoma State Chapter. During your first year or two of membership, we encourage you to enrich your P.E.O. experience by checking off each of the following:

- Read The P.E.O. Record.
- Meet each of your chapter sisters.
- Read about the P.E.O.
 Founders and the history of
 P.E.O. Check with your chapter
 president for books she has in
 her supplies.
- Substitute as a guard or other officer at a meeting.

- Give a report on one of our P.E.O. projects.
- Visit your P.E.O. websites both International and your own state, provincial or district (s/p/d) – ask your president for the username and password and for the s/p/d website address.
- Attend your state, provincial or district convention.
- Make it a point to visit with a different sister and really get to know her.
- When we can have programs at our in-person meetings again, think about sharing a talent or interest by giving a program.
- Offer to give a virtual program sharing your talents or interests.

As you attend your chapter meetings and participate in socials and fundraisers you will learn more about P.E.O. More importantly, you will form a bond with your new sisters.

Even if you have been a P.E.O. for a while, make it your goal to check off each of these activities this year.
