Think of the joy you could bring to a chapter sister you haven't seen for a while with a simple phone call to wish her "Happy Holidays" or to see how she is doing. Consider writing holiday greeting cards to the members of your chapter. You might bake some cookies and leave them on the doorstep of those who are most in need of holiday cheer.

★ Do you have chapter members who are struggling financially? Consider showing loving concern and gifting their dues.
