# COLORADO STATE COMMITTEES

There are many opportunities for Colorado P.E.O. Sisters to assist with the ongoing work of the Sisterhood by serving on a state committee. Below is a brief description for each committee. A state officer serves as an advisor to each committee. Committees work via phone, email, and meetings as necessary throughout the year.

Expenses incurred while conducting committee business are reimbursed. This includes travel, lodging, meals, and state convention. All members of state committees are voting delegates to the Convention of Colorado State Chapter. For additional information or if you have questions, please contact the State Vice President.

## International

### **Five International Projects Committees (ELF, IPS, PCE, PSA, STAR) – 2 members, 2-year term**

Serve as a resource to local chapters, encourage chapters to seek recipients through educational programs. Find speakers for convention and provide a display.

## State

### **Colorado State Chapter Executive Board – 5 elected members, 5-year term**

An appointed committee accepts applications for a position on the Colorado State Chapter EB

### **CPCC Board of Directors – 4 elected members, 4-year term (one PSP)**

An appointed committee accepts applications for a position on the CPCC BoD

### **Marguerite Fund Trustees – 3 members, 3-year term**

Trustees meet twice a year to review applications and determine distribution of funds to recipients. The chair is also a member of the Colorado P.E.O. Charitable Corporation Board of Directors (CPCC)

### **Chapter House Trustees – 3 members, 3-year term**

Trustees meet four to six times each year to oversee the upkeep and management of Chapter House. The chair is also a member of the Colorado P.E.O. Charitable Corporation Board of Directors (CPCC)

### **Colorado State Scholarship Committee – 3 members, 3-year term**

Encourage local chapters to seek recipients and act as a resource, promote contributions to the Colorado State Scholarship Fund. Receive and review scholarship applications. Find a speaker for convention and provide a table display

### **Colorado Cottey Scholarship Committee – 3 members, 3-year term**

A combined International and State committee. Coordinate visits of the Cottey representative, promote interest in Cottey College, communicate with current students, encourage Local Chapters and Reciprocities to seek students. Serve as a resource, award scholarships from the Colorado Cottey College Scholarship Fund. Find a speaker for State Convention and provide a display.

## Standing

### **Amendments and Recommendations Committee (A&R) – 3 members, 3-year term, (one PSP)**

Review and finalize proposed amendments and distribute them by May 1.

### **Finance Committee – 3 members, 3-year term, (one PSP)**

Prepare budgets and review expenditures of state committees and the executive board.

### **History – 2 members, 2-year term**

Archive programs for use by local chapters and maintains the organizational histories of Colorado chapters. Responsible for presentation of anniversary chapters at state convention

### **Membership Committee – 7 members, 3-year term (one PSP)**

Work with approximately 50 local chapters in your district to promote chapter health and growth.

### **State Unaffiliate Chair – 1 member, 3-year term**

Maintain the lists of unaffiliate members, by district, for posting on the website and sharing with reciprocities and chapters upon request.
