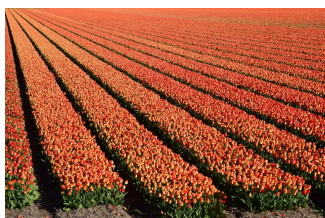


## Colorado P.E.O. Charitable Corporation Mid April 2022 Newsletter
