Their charge is to 1) study what other P.E.O. state chapters have done with the proceeds from the sale of chapter house properties and 2) develop a proposal for utilizing the proceeds from the sale of the Colorado State Chapter House that conforms with the CPCC articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. They began their work on June 30, 2022. They plan to meet twice monthly and report to the CPCC board every month. <u>Their final proposal is due November 1, 2022.</u>

The CPCC board is grateful that these sisters are willing to serve in this capacity and we look forward to receiving their proposal!

It was a special time for the trustees of the Fund to be able to meet and express our gratitude to all of you in person for supporting those who receive help through the Marguerite Fund. **You, indeed, ARE the Marguerite Fund!**

Following procedure, the members of the trustee board transitioned positions at the state convention. We had the opportunity to show our appreciation to Barb Hunter, outgoing Chair, for the loving concern that was always at the center of her work during her three-year term on the board. In late June the regular semi-annual meeting of the Marguerite Fund Trustees was held to review applications to the Fund and to evaluate our procedures and documentation, making certain that they are relevant to current needs. Fourteen re-applications to the Fund were approved as was one new application. Fifteen women will each receive \$500 in August, the first month of our six-month funding cycle.

Note here that recipients of the Fund who have not completed their twelve-month eligibility must re-apply in July and January. There were, in fact, two recipients who had been receiving help that declined to re-apply. One stated that she was, with the aid of Marguerite funding, in a better place and she thought that the funds should be directed to someone else. **YOU made a real difference in her life!**

Thank you, our sisters, for your continuing support. As you can see by the numbers, the need is real and ongoing. From a mom struggling to recover from illness to a student or senior living on a fixed income in this time of rising prices, **thank you**.
