Yearbook Chapter Budget Inclusion

There have been a number of questions about the new requirement to include a budget in your chapter yearbook. Please remember that a budget is a work in progress and can be adjusted to correspond to your chapter receipts and membership. An example of a chapter budget can be found at the following links:

The International site has so many resources, please check there, in your IOLC (Instructions for Officers of Local Chapters) and in your Constitution for answers to commonly asked questions.

Chapter President's Letter to President of State Chapter (Cori Tanner) should be read at your February meeting and uploaded by March 31st.

Chapter Yearbooks should be uploaded by May 1st.

Remember to install all chapter officers even if remaining in the same office in March - and please give your President her gavel pin when she is installed. We don't make initiates wait for a year for their emblems, they are a sister from the minute they are initiated. Your Chapter President is a President the minute she is installed.

Virtual Ceremony of Initiation

Instructions for a virtual ceremony of Initiation were mailed to Chapter Presidents in January. This is new for all of us. Your State Officers will be going to virtual training on this procedure in February.

If you have questions feel free to reach out to any of your State Officers.



The new P.E.O. International website launch with Single Sign On (SSO) will be unveiled in early February.

Each P.E.O. member needs a valid email address on file with P.E.O. International and a personal password to log in to the site and have access to member protected content.

The website will direct members to set up a password (must be at least 12 characters in length and contain at least one numeric, one alphabetic and one special character) the first time; each user will retain her own private password. (Hint, this should not be a generic password that you use for all your secure sites. A phrase such as "I love to eat bagels for breakfast at 9 am while reciting the Objects and Aims." is easier to remember.)

The executive office will not know member passwords, but a "Forgot Password" feature will be available if you forget or lose your password.

Remember that you will need to update the year at the end of the password for initial entry into International and our state website.

Local Chapter Annual Report Training is Coming

Annual Report Online Processing for Local Chapter Presidents, Treasurer and Corresponding Secretary is approaching!

This training is **highly** recommended for smooth online processing.

Training will cover these important steps:

The training video will be available after February 1 on the International Website.

Local chapter presidents, treasurers and corresponding secretaries will receive an email on March 1 notifying them the annual report system is available.
