- 2. Female in her senior year of high school and will be graduating in May 2024 or be receiving her \*GED in May 2024
- 3. Citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States
- 4. Plans to attend a trade/technical school or accredited institution of higher education in the United States for professional growth and success
- 5. Submit a completed application
